Don't Miss Special Farm Safety Tractor Rollover Demos

Local fire departments will rescue a mannequin trapped underneath a tractor.

The displays will help Michigan farmers handle these scenarios and properly implement the Rollover Protective Structure (ROPS) system on their tractors.

"Tractor rollovers are still the leading cause of fatalities among farmers in the U.S.," said Dan Neenan, director of The National Educational Center for Agricultural Safety (NECAS), a safety education and proactive programs provider.

During the AgroExpo, Neenan will lead several rescue tractor rollover demonstrations, which will provide a hands-on look at the causes of tractor rollovers and the safety devices used to stabilize tractors, like ROPS.

According to Bob Fraker, safety manager for AgroLiquid, the recommended tools will help show the various types of rollovers, essential farm equipment, and several evolutions of patient extrication.

"It's understanding that the actions that need to be taken while planting and harvesting include slowing down, not skipping steps, and making sure that you do everything you can in that short time frame to meet that demand to get the plants in the ground or to make the best harvest season you can with yield growth," Fraker wrote in an email to *Michigan Farm News*.

"I would really push Dan Neenan at the event. He's a very high, respectable leader out of Iowa, and if there are any questions, he always gives time to answer those."

Recent Bureau of Labor Statistics data show the agricultural sector is still the most dangerous in America with 417 fatalities. Specifically, fall harvest time can be one of the busiest and most dangerous seasons of the year for the agriculture industry, and one of the reasons why the third week of September has been recognized as National Farm Safety and Health Week.

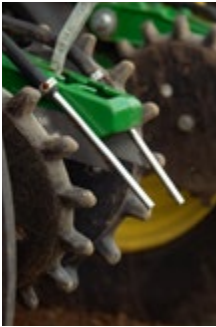

The numbers are hard to argue with. In 2025, John Deere's See & Spray technology delivered an average savings of \$12.63 per acre — after license fees — across every field where it was deployed. For a 1,000-acre operation, that's more than \$12,000 back in your pocket in a single season. Not from a better price on inputs. Not from a new financing deal. From a sprayer that learned how to think.

WHAT IT DOES

See & Spray uses a network of high-resolution cameras mounted across the boom to scan every inch of ground as your sprayer moves through the field. THE ROI CASE

Traditional broadcast spraying covers every square foot of ground at full rate, regardless of whether a weed is actually there. See & Spray changes that equation entirely. Industry data consistently shows herbicide savings of more than 60% in fallow applications, and 2025 field studies confirmed a positive return on investment in every single field tested.

The cost structure is worth understanding: the license fee is \$5 per acre, but it's only charged on acres where it does not see any weeds and no chemicals are used.

Weather Considerations for Effective Agricultural Management

AUSTIN PEARSON *Climatologist*

Weather is one of the most critical factors influencing agricultural decision-making. This presentation will focus on the Midwestern Regional Climate Center's United Soybean Board — funded Ag Climate Dashboard, which brings together weather, climate, and agronomic information to support on-farm decisions throughout the growing season. We will highlight key decision-support tools for planting, pesticide timing, disease monitoring, and harvest planning, as well as the importance of local weather observations from mesonet stations. The presentation will conclude with a fall climate outlook and its implications for late-season field operations and preparation for the next growing season.



Pearson is a climatologist with the Midwestern Regional Climate Center (MRCC) and Indiana State Climate Office (IN-SCO), where he serves as Assistant State Climatologist and leads the development of climate products and decision-support tools for agriculture, natural resources, and public stakeholders across Indiana and the Midwest. He co-coordinates Indiana CoCoRaHS, co-manages the Purdue Mesonet, and co-leads Indiana's weekly contributions to the U.S. Drought Monitor, focusing on translating complex climate data into actionable insights. Austin holds B.S. and M.S. degrees in Applied Meteorology and Climatology from Purdue University and has experience with Purdue Extension.

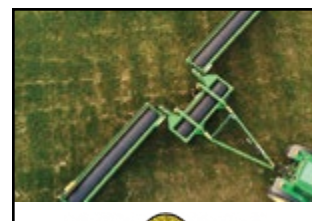

Michigan Valley Irrigation Don't Miss the Latest in Fertigation, Irrigation Tech

Michigan growers will learn how to spoon-feed fertilizer to avoid nitrogen and phosphorus run-off, and nutrient overloading after a storm hits unexpectedly.

Michigan Valley Irrigation (MVI) Co., which has locations in Vassar, McBride, and Caledonia, will be field-demoing the latest in fertigation technology during the 2026 AgroExpo.

According to John McGee, president of MVI, the field demo's center pivot and injection pump equipment will feature a blue dye visual aid that shows how chemical and injection pumps move through your pivot, and how producers can uniformly apply nutrients through a pivot onto their crops.

"We have to optimize our yields in our fields because the cost of inputs has gotten so high," McGee told *Michigan Farm News*.

"There's a classic example where somebody puts on a season's worth of nitrogen on their corn, and then it

rains 4-5 inches and leeches it out. We can combat phosphorus leakage ... by spoon-feeding these nutrients. You're not overloading, there is no runoff, and you're only giving the crop exactly what it needs, when it needs it."

This comes at a time when producers have already had to deal with wetter and cooler weather: McGee said many corn producers are still trying to recover from the late start. In addition, MVI lost 50 pivots due to severe storms in April and May.

"Michigan Valley's goal is to maximize yields and optimize water application and injection technology," McGee added. "Coupled with AgroLiquid's offerings of crop nutrition and it's a perfect way to boost yields and guarantee outcomes."

SOYBEANS TO THE RESCUE

Michigan Farmer-Firefighter Pushes PFAS-Free Foam

Doctors diagnosed Patrick Butler with bladder cancer three years ago. He didn't know for sure what caused it, yet he can't stop blaming Aqueous Film-Forming Foam (AFFF).

You see, Butler served as a firefighter for 34 years, and AFFF, which contains fluorinated compounds, including per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), is one tool firefighters use to combat hard-to-put-out fires. However, PFAS may be harmful to human health, according to the Environmental Protection Agency.

Now the 76-year-old Butler is on a mission to protect firefighters — and help soybean farmers — via a soybean-based firefighting foam that doesn't contain harmful chemicals.

"I've got my cancer taken care of, but it's always in the back of your mind," said Butler, a Calhoun County Farm Bureau member. "I'm always thinking about it. I go and get checked every year. So far, knock on wood, I'm cancer-free. Still, I don't want firefighters to experience that."

During AgroExpo, Butler will host several farm safety fire suppression sessions, including five live safety burns with the St. Johns Fire Department. Butler said there'll be extinguishers, and "we'll be flowing foam and putting out fires."

Funded by the United Soybean Board,

Cross Plains Solutions' soy-foam concentrate is free of PFAS and flourines, 70% bio-based, and biodegradable. Every 55-gallon drum of SoyFoam TF 1122 contains 2.5 bushels of soybeans.

Butler is a dealer of the foam. He said it costs roughly \$179 per five-gallon pail, which is similar to AFFF's cost.

"What about the young (firefighter) coming in?" asked Butler, co-owner of PK Foam Solutions.

"You know, if we can sell a few more soybeans in the state of Michigan and make a safe product, we need to be doing that."

Cross Plains Solutions released SoyFoam TF 1122 last April. Already, Michigan fire departments in Caro and Interlochen use the foam. Butler said his goal is to make the foam widely available.

"It's made from U.S. soybeans and other agricultural products," Butler told *Michigan Farm News*.

"It has a vapor suppression, good for Class A and B fires — which are wood, combustible materials, or hydrocarbon fuel sources — doesn't require any special handling requirements, and it's designed to work with the traditional foam dispensing equipment that they've been using for years.

"It's fluorine-free, it's bio-based, it's biodegradable, and it's certifiable by the USDA."

According to Hanna Campbell, market development director of the Michigan Soybean Committee, the soy foam is made from soy flour, which plays a role in the meal side of soybeans. Currently, Campbell said educational events and demonstrations are being held across the state this summer to help spread the word about the foam.

"Having these other options of things like soy foam that use that meal side, that soy flour, is all the more important at a time when you see growth in the biofuels industry," Campbell told *Michigan Farm News*.

"(Butler) is very passionate about it being PFAS free, about this foam solution — not only because he lives in a rural community and does farm, but also just from a firefighter safety side. We're working not only with Cross Plain Solutions, but also directly with PK Foam Solutions to help get the word out about the product."

According to Butler, the foam can be sprayed at extreme temperatures — down to 12 below freezing — and leaves nitrogen on top of the ground when it biodegrades, which "makes your grass grow."

"It's easy to clean up," added Butler, "and it's good for the environment, it's good for our firefighters, and it's good for farmers."

"It's a win-win across the board."

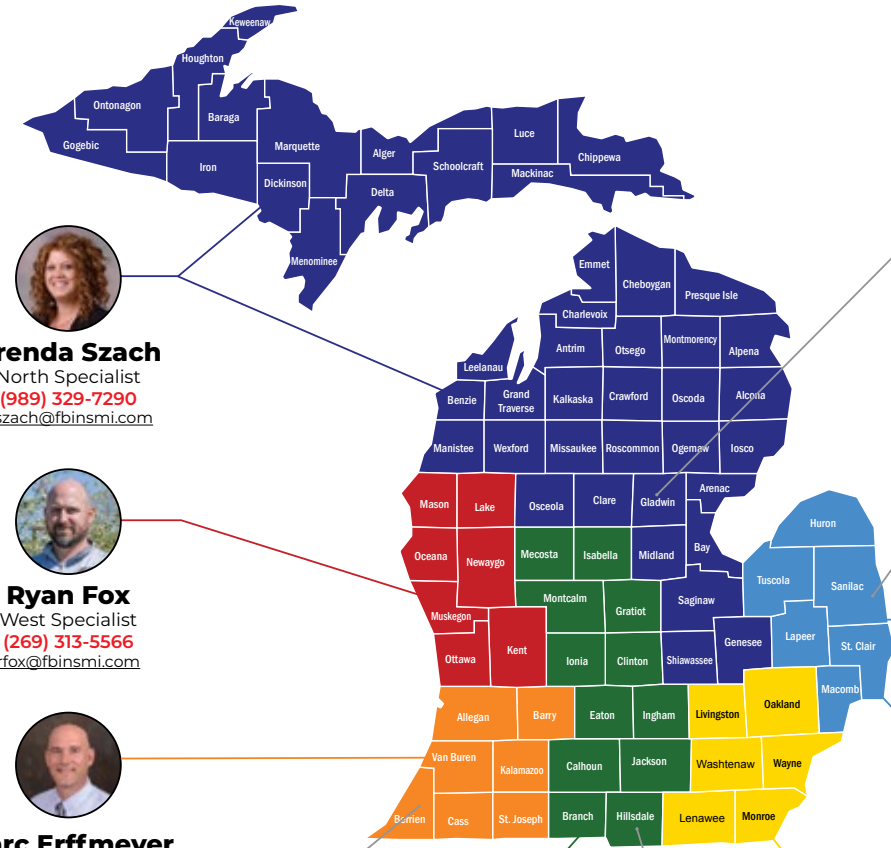
